**REGISTRATION FEE:** \$10.00 per participant – All fees will be charged to your unit accounts. A special Klondike

Derby patch will be presented to each scout registered.

**REGISTRATION TIME:** 8:00 – 8:45 am. The patrol leader must provide a unit roster and Daily Home Screening for

each participant. There will be a sled inspection at this time.

**EQUIPMENT REQUIRED:** The following equipment will be needed by each sled team:

## MASK FOR EACH PERSON

- Notebook and pencil
- Sleeping bag or blanket
- Two (2) –Six (6) foot poles
- Eight (8) 6' lengths of rope
- Bow saw and hand axe, properly sheathed
- Compass
- Patrol First Aid Kit
- ¼" or 3/8" x 50' line

- Knife
- Sharpening tool
- Matches, flint & steel
- Dry wood and fire starters (candles, wax-soaked cardboard, etc.) are optional
- No liquid fuels are permitted
- Ground cloth
- Small piece of twine or string

- Lunch and a drink for each Scout
- Cooking utensils if they are preparing a meal for their lunch.
- Patrol flag
- Scout handbooks may be on the sled, but it will be up to the individual judges to determine if the Scouts may use them.
